Regional Utilities is excited to announce the upgrade of our Seacrest Wastewater Treatment Plant. In the ever-growing and expanding area of south Walton County, it is important to stay ahead of the pace of growth. That is exactly why Regional Utilities is doubling the treatment plant capacity of our Seacrest Wastewater Treatment Plant from 2 to 4 million gallons per day. This wastewater treatment plant currently provides service to the eastern portion of the Regional Utilities service area along County Road 30A from Eastern Lake to Rosemary Beach and from Peach Creek to Watersound along U.S. Highway 98. This plant capacity upgrade will help to ensure the Regional Utilities system can continue to provide quality service to the rapidly growing franchise area.
